- 1. Organizing Authority: Peter & Paisley
- 2. Headquarters: The official Regatta headquarters shall be Paisley's parents house at 2317 Middleton Beach Road, Middleton (Madison), Wisconsin
- 3. Rules: The regatta shall be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, the Notice of Race, and the Vanguard 15 Class Rules unless modified by the Sailing Instructions. Sunday's Team Racing shall also be governed by Appendix D of the RRS.
- 4. Eligibility: Open to all Vanguard 15 Class yachts. Helmsmen must be members of the Vanguard 15 Class Association.
- 5. Entry: Entry Forms and Fees shall be received by 09:30 Saturday June 21st. The combined entry fee for both fleet racing and team racing is \$75. Entries not received by Friday June 13th shall be charged a \$10 late fee. The Organizing Authority, based on the results from Saturday's Fleet Racing, shall form teams for Sunday's Team Racing.
- 6. Schedule
 - Friday June 20th Registration
 - 1900- 2100 hours, Registration and UW Tech Racing (not part of regatta scoring), Memorial Union Terrace, UW Campus. Please contact Ray Pingree at (608) 244-3336 to arrange for a Tech to race.
 - Saturday June 21st Fleet Racing
 - 0830-0930 hours: Registration, Marshall Park Launch Site
 - 0930 hours: Competitors briefing, Marshall Park Launch Site
 - 1045 hours: Warning, first race. Additional races to follow.
 - Approximately 1230, Lunch (provided).
 - After racing, post race activities (Beer, trophies, dinner, announcement of teams for Sunday racing), Paisley's parents house.
 - Sunday June 22nd Team Racing
 - 0900 hours: Competitors briefing ashore, Marshall Park Launch Site
 - 0945 hours: Warning, first flight. Other flights to follow as soon as practicable. It is the
 intention of the Organizing Authority to run a complete rotation before returning to shore
 for lunch. In case this is not possible races will be scheduled as permitted BUT, no race
 will be started after 4 pm regardless of the number of races completed.

- 7. Sailing Instructions: Shall be available at Competitors briefings

- 11. Housing: All competitors shall make their own housing arrangements.
